About My Number

The individual number ("My Number") is a 12-digit number assigned to each resident with a certificate of residence in Japan. The number is unrelated to the person's address or date of birth to prevent identifying the individual it was assigned to. My Number is used to create a fair and just society.

(1) Individual Number Notification Letter

An Individual Number Notification Letter is mailed to an individual (e.g. a newborn baby) who is issued a new My Number. This Notification Letter cannot be used as proof of My Number.

(2) My Number Card (individual number card)

A My Number Card (Individual Number Card) can be used as proof of My Number or an ID.

My Number Card (individual number card) Applications (Noncompulsory)

Fill in the My Number Card Issuance Application Form and Electronic Certificate Issuance Application Form attached to the Notification Card or Individual Number Notification Letter, affix your photograph to it, and send it back using the provided return envelope.

*In addition to application by postal mail, it is possible to apply by smartphone, computer and (supporting) certificate photo machines found throughout the city. The Ota City My Number Card Center can also assist you in taking a photograph and completing the application (appointment required).

- · There is no initial issuance fee.
- When a My Number Card (individual number card) is issued, the Notification Card and a Basic Resident Registrar Card (if any) are to be returned.
- When there is a change to the information given on the Notification Card (name or address), you will be unable to apply using the application form attached to the notification card. For details, contact the Household Residents Registry Division or Branch Office (P17).
- If you lose your My Number Card Issuance Application Form and Electronic Certificate
 Issuance Application Form, you can have it reissued at the Household Residents
 Registry Division of the Ota City Office, the Ota City My Number Card Center, or one of
 the Branch Offices (Bring your Residence Card, driver's license card, or any other form
 of ID with you).
- The My Number Card will expire when your residence permit expires (Excluding permanent residents).

2 Receiving your My Number Card (individual number card)

The Ota City Office will mail a letter of notification and instructions to you as soon as your My Number Card is issued. The Card will be handed to you at the City Office.

Follow your appointment instructions including when and where to pick it up. Come to the appointed place at the appointed time with the letter of notification sent to you and your Residence Card or Special Permanent Resident Certificate.

If you have a Notification Card and/or a Basic Resident Registration Card, please give them back when your My Number Card is issued.

(3) My Number FAQ

- Q. What should I be careful of when using My Number?
- A. Except as required by law, do not let someone know your My Number, or make a copy or note of your My Number. Do not use your My Number as a password or post it on the internet.
- Q. Can you freely change your My Number?
- A. In general, your My Number stays the same for your whole life. It can be changed, but only if there is a possibility that it has been used illegally.
- Q. Do I need to make a My Number Card?
- A. Although it is optional, it is more convenient if you have one.
- Q. After I received my My Number Card, my period of residence was renewed. Is the validity period of the card automatically extended?
- A. Even though your period of residence was renewed, the validity period of your My Number Card is not automatically extended.
 - You must complete the necessary procedures to extend the validity period of your My Number Card at the service counter of the Household Residents Registry Division. If the validity period is exceeded, the My Number Card will become invalid. It can be reissued for a small fee (1,000 yen).
- Q. I am not sure how to apply for a My Number Card. Can I receive help to get one?
- A. The Ota City My Number Card Center can assist you through the process of applying for a My Number Card, including taking the required photo and completing the application, free of charge. Please make an appointment in advance by calling the Ota City My Number Call Center (0570-03-3370, weekdays 9:00 17:00) or online through the Ota City Government Website. Bring your Residence Card or other form of ID with you to your appointment.

(4) Automatic certificate issuance machines that accept My Number Cards (Individual Number Cards)

You can use automatic certificate issuance machines that accept My Number Cards to issue copies of Residence Certificates, Registered Seal Certificates and other documents. Certificate issuance machines are available on the first floor of the Ota City Office Main Building, at the Ota City My Number Card Center, and at major convenience stores nationwide.


