


















Event

Daycare Center Applications (for Use from April 2026) and Consultations

[Applications for authorized daycare centers]

Eligibility

Children who are unable to stay home due to the employment of their parent(s) or guardian(s), including job hunting, illness, childbirth, nursing care or caregiving duties, school attendance, or similar reason.

- Obtaining the required documents The 2026 "Daycare Center Application Guidebook" and documents necessary for application will be available at the application counter from Thursday, September 25. Confirmation of the status of residence will be required for foreign nationals.



Park Your Bicycle in Bicycle Parking Lots

Per city ordinance, Ota City designates areas around stations as "no bicycle parking zones," and regularly impounds unattended bicycles in these zones. Impounded bicycles are generally held for 30 days at an Impounded Bicycle Storage Center and will be disposed of if not claimed within this time frame.

Please make use of bicycle parking lots and do not leave your bicycle in public spaces (e.g. along roads and in front of stations).
