
The orientation will include explanations of school supplies necessary for elementary school, school events, and other important matters. Parents who have already sent their children to elementary school will also be there to share their experiences.



Have you just started a job in nursing care or are you interested in a nursing care career? Ota City offers a "Japanese used in nursing care" course to make your path easier.






[Regarding Resident Tax Payments]



months (February, April, June, August, October, and December)


