Vaccine Announcement



Start of vaccinations for the elderly (65 years and over)

The city has been working on the vaccination of people living in institutions for the elderly, where the risk of mass infection and serious illness is particularly high. We are pleased to announce that we are ready to send vaccination tickets to everyone aged 65 and over. We will also enclose a preliminary examination form, a list of vaccination venues and an explanation of the vaccination. (The vaccination tickets will be delivered by the 21st of May.)

※Elderly people (born on or before April 1, 1957) who are registered residents of Ota City are eligible.

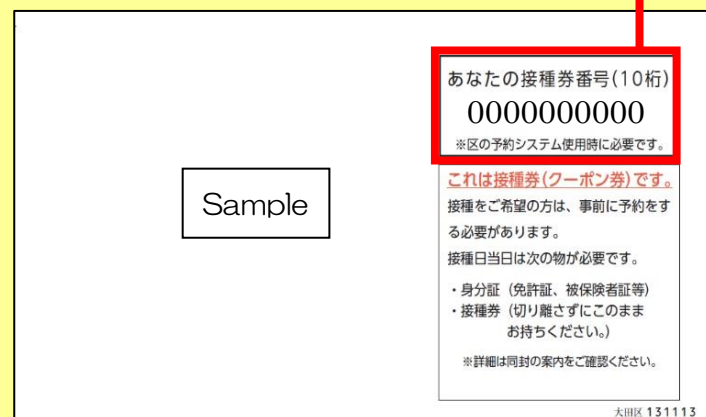
1 Vaccination ticket arrives

(It should arrive around May 21st)

It will arrive in an orange envelope

2 Reserve

Reservations for “group vaccinations” will be available from Friday 21 May, and “individual vaccinations” from Tuesday 1 June. Please see the reverse side of this page for information on vaccination venues and reservations.

※Reservations will not be taken at the City Office, area office or branch offices.

In the early days, it may be difficult to get an appointment, but by the end of June we expect to have enough of the vaccine to cover everyone over the age of 65. Those aged 75 and over who are considered to be at higher risk of serious illness are advised to make an appointment as soon as possible.

3 Vaccination day

Please bring the following:

- Vaccination ticket
- Completed preliminary examination form (please take your temperature at home on the day of the vaccination)
- Proof of identity (Residence card, Driving license, Health insurance card, etc.)

※Please wear clothes where you can easily

Allow 3 weeks after the first vaccination before receiving the second vaccination.

Appointments (Vaccinations must be reserved in advance)

When making a reservation for your first appointment, please also reserve your second appointment (for 3 weeks later). “Group vaccinations” at city facilities will begin first, but many appointments will also be available for “individual vaccination” at medical institutions. You can also visit your local medical institution or family doctor for vaccinations.

We had originally planned to take reservations on a weekly basis, but now that we have a better idea of the vaccine supply, **we will accept reservations until the end of July** (we will also accept appointments for the second vaccination at the same time as the first).

Reservations will be accepted from 1st June onwards, starting with the medical institutions that are ready. (Vaccinations will start from 7 June)

Some medical institutions* will be accepting reservations from 21st May (vaccinations from 25th May onwards). **Arai Clinic (Higashi-Kojiya), Ikegami Minami Internal Clinic (Ikegami), Suzuki Clinic (Omori-Nishi), Hasunuma Clinic (Nishi-Kamata)*



▲ About venues

Please make a reservation through the **Ota City Novel Coronavirus Vaccination Call Center** or the **Ota City Reservation System**. Please refer to the list of medical institutions enclosed with your vaccination ticket to find out where you can make an appointment. Please note that you cannot make appointments for both group and individual vaccinations, or at more than one medical institution. Also, please refrain from contacting medical institutions directly, as this may interfere with their normal operations.

Those who need to be careful when vaccinating

Those who cannot receive a vaccination	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Fever of 37.5° C or higher on the day of vaccination ● Have not reserved ● You are suffering from a serious acute illness ● Have had a severe allergic reaction to any of the ingredients in this vaccine (see instructions enclosed with your vaccination ticket).
Those who need to be careful	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Currently being treated for one of the following illnesses: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • People undergoing treatment for heart disease, kidney disease, liver disease, blood disorders, immune deficiency, etc. • You have a disease that makes it difficult to stop bleeding or you are taking blood-thinning medicines (anticoagulants) ● Have had one of the following symptoms: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Severe allergic reactions to medicines and foods • Seizures

Please consult your doctor or other health care professional before vaccinating.

Schedule for those under 64

① Those aged 60~64 years old	Vaccination tickets will be sent out in late July . Those in ① do not need to apply, however tickets will be sent to those in ② and ③ according to priority after applying. Vaccinations will start late July . Please make an appointment when you receive your vaccination ticket. More information about ② or ③ (details, how to apply, etc.) can be found on the Ota City website. *Information will also be published in the 1 st June issue of the Ota Kuho.
② Those aged 16~59 years old with underlying medical conditions	
③ Those aged 16~59 years old who are in institutions for the elderly etc.	
Those aged 16~59 years old	The timing of the mailing of vaccination tickets is still being worked out. It will be announced on the city website as soon as it is decided.
